### NOTICE OF INTENT TO ADOPT AN INTEGRATED REGIONAL WATER MANAGEMENT PLAN

The Regional Water Authority (RWA) will hold a public hearing on May 18, 2006 to consider adopting an Integrated Regional Water Management Plan (IRWMP) for portions of Placer, El Dorado, and Sacramento counties. RWA is a joint powers authority created to represent regional water supply interests and assist more than 20 member agencies with protecting and enhancing the reliability, availability, affordability and quality of water resources.

The IRWMP is being prepared cooperatively by RWA, Sacramento County Water Agency, and the Freeport Regional Water Authority. The IRWMP identifies and prioritizes regional projects that provide multiple benefits for water supply, water recycling, water use efficiency, habitat improvement, and recreation.

The public is invited to attend and provide comments at an RWA Board hearing on May 18, 2006, which will begin at 9 a.m. at Carmichael Water District at 7837 Fair Oaks Boulevard in Carmichael, CA.
